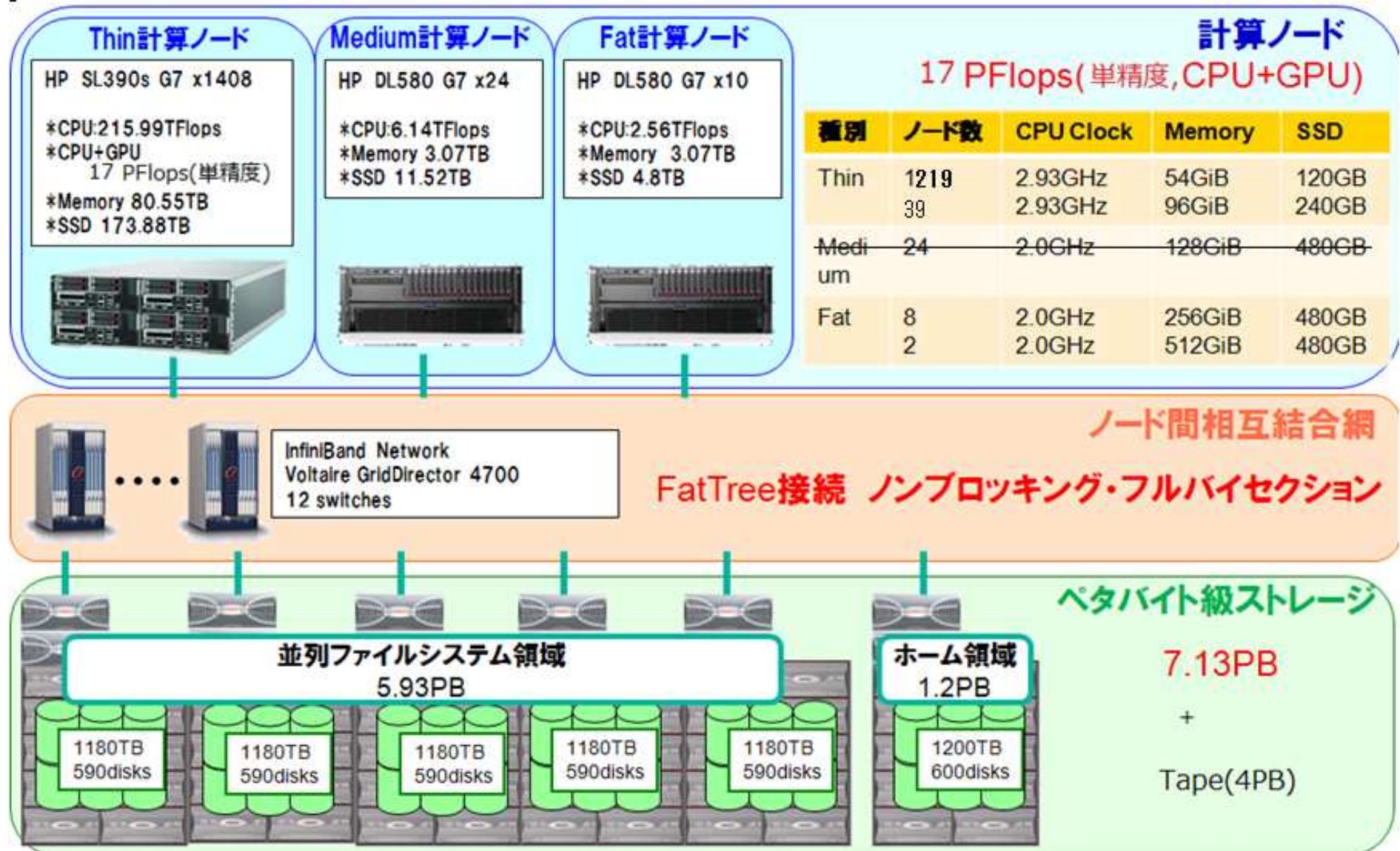
What is TSUBAME2.5?

- TSUBAME2.0 was introduced in November 2010 at the Global Scientific Information and Computing Center, Tokyo Institute of Technology. In September 2013, TSUBAME2.0 was upgraded to a new version called TSUBAME2.5 which is a large-scale cloud-based green supercomputer equipped with new-generation K20X GPU.
- Total performance: 17 Pflops (single precision) /5.7 Pflops (double precision)
- Total Storage: 7PB Mass storage + 4PB tape device
- Network: High bandwidth infiniband network

TSUBAME is the abbreviation of

**Tokyo-tech Supercomputer and UBiquitously Accessible Mass-storage Environment
which was selected through public invitation.**
